

For medication administration during school hours, read the below requirements.

If your child needs to have medication(s)/treatment(s) given during the school day, state regulations and school board policy require that you and your doctor provide written permission (medication authorization treatment form) for administration of both prescribed and over-the-counter medication(s) or treatment(s). This is for **any medication. This includes cough drops, cold medicine, and OTC allergy medication.**

Medication refers only to those products which have been approved by the “Food and Drug Administration” (FDA) for use as a drug.

Prescribed medications must arrive in a container with the original, unaltered prescription label attached and the parent/guardian needs to drop it off to the school R.N.

A parent/guardian can come to the school to administer a medication if necessary.
